Ordered, The Joint-Committee on Roads and Bridges to which were referred the Orders in relation to Dublin Street, has considered the same and would respectfully

Report: That the object desired cannot be attained unless the Road Street shall be laid out, as originally contemplated, as far as Garden Street crosses, Dana and Parker decline to give their land, if the street is to be laid out no further than Walden Street, or the Range way westerly of the land of Jonas Weyeth & Co.

The Committee would therefore recommend that the Orders, as originally adopted by the Board of Aldermen, be adopted, and the street laid out through to Garden Street.
