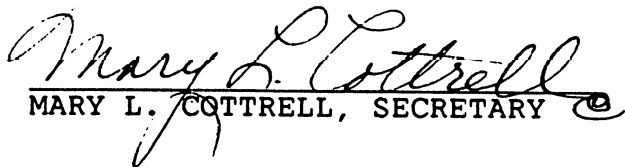
The new regulations would adopt Federal standards so that the Department of Public Utilities would continue to be certified to carry out enforcement activities in Massachusetts.

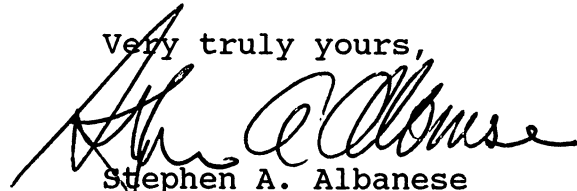
