
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge lights many streets that are, in effect, private ways used only by institutions such as Harvard and M.I.T.; and
- WHEREAS: We can ill afford to pay the 'light bill' in such cases; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to have the City Engineer and the City Electrician survey and make a list of all such streets and report back to Council as soon as possible; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the City Electrician to make certain the light behind the Fresh Pond Golf Course at the bottom of the hill is turned off during daylight hours and to further investigate the possibility of installing machines on the tennis courts which turn the lights on by inserting quarters for a given period of time.
