In Board of Aldermen, July 6th 1864

The joint Standing Committee on roads and bridges, to whom was referred the petition of Abraham Edwards and others, that Donald St. may be laid out as a public high way, have considered the same, and would respectfully report.

The Committee recommend when the abutters of said St. furnish a plan, showing it to be 40 feet in width, free from all encroachment and graded to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of streets, the same be laid out as a public highway.
