WHEREAS: At a recent meeting at Weaver Apartments where seniors living in the apartment were given the opportunity to discuss means of making their neighborhood safer for them, the following items were listed by them as areas of concern,

1. Bushes on Clifton Street side of the entrance to the MBTA kept trimmed for better visibility.
2. Gate left ajar on left side (high chain link fence) going into entrance to the Head House could be place where potential assailants could hide in wait.
3. Continued surveillance of the area of Russell field to discourage public drinking and drug usage; now therefore be it

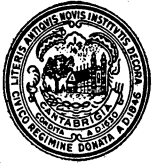
