WHEREAS: The Department of Public Works is constructing a new facility at the Hampshire Street site, and

WHEREAS: Construction has caused various soil effects underneath the facility, and

WHEREAS: As a result of construction rodents and vermin are moving out from under the facility and into the surrounding homes, therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to instruct the Health Department to inspect all homes near the new facility on Hampshire Street, Elm Street, Norfolk Street, and Tremont Street to ascertain whether or not there has been a recent influx of rodents and vermin, and be it further

ORDERED: That the results of this survey be forwarded to the City Council as soon as possible and if in effect there has been an influx of rodents and vermin, then the City at its expense should provide free extermination services to all effected residents.
