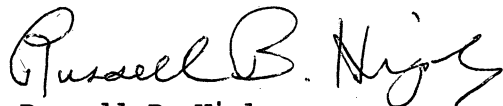

Dear Mr. Healy:

As you know, the City Council requested that this office draft a proposed home rule petition to amend the Rent Control Special Act so as to allow exemptions for three units (including the owners) in owner-occupied four, five and six unit rent controlled buildings. The Council order requested that the proposed home rule petition be submitted to the Council by May 22, 1989. In order to properly address all of the issues raised by the proposed amendment we will require an additional week to complete the work.
