This is to inform you that effective immediately, we the undersigned resign from the Cambridge City Council's Rent Control Committee.


Over the past year and a half, both of us, Councillors with differing views on Rent Control, have been frustrated by the lack of leadership and direction by the Chair of the Committee.

More recently, the Chair has scheduled a series of neighborhood meetings to discuss Rent Control without the courtesy of informing or inviting either one of us. This is ironic since the Chair was quoted in the April 20, 1993, edition of the Cambridge Tab, as stating: "We need a clear housing policy in the city." and "We have to try to work together."


It is obvious that the Chair's idea of working together does not include other members of the Committee. We find the Chair's actions to be arrogant and contradictory.
