At a meeting of the County Commissioners for the County of Middlesex, holden at Cambridge, within and for said County, on the first Tuesday of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six

The inhabitants of Cambridge,

in said County, by their petition to said Commissioners—among other matters—pray that Aberdeen Avenue, Bay State Road, Broadway, Charles Street, Essex Street, Field Street, First Street, Franklin Street, Garden Street, Haskell Street, Kinnaird Street, Lincoln Street and Sparks Street, in said Cambridge, may be specifically repaired,

as will more fully appear, reference being had to the petition filed of record in the case.

The petition was presented to the County Commissioners at their meeting holden at Cambridge, within and for said County, on the first Tuesday of June, A.D. 19 65, when and where notice was ordered given to all persons and corporations interested therein of the time and place when and where said Commissioners would meet for the purpose of viewing the premises and hearing the parties as by their order of notice on file and of record will more fully appear.

At the time of said view and hearing, said Commissioners adjudged said specific repairs of common convenience and necessity; and thence said petition has been continued to this time.

And now the said Commissioners make partial return of their proceedings in the premises, as follows: said Commissioners having given notice as the law directs, met at the Superior Court House in said Cambridge, on the fifth day of August, in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-five, when and where the parties appeared, to wit, the petitioners by Mr. Ralph J. Dunphy, Commissioner of Public Works and the respondent by no parties appeared to object.

The premises having been examined, and the parties fully heard, said Commissioners

proceeded to direct that Aberdeen Avenue, Bay State Road, Broadway Charles Street, Essex Street, Field Street, First Street, Franklin Street, Garden Street, Haskell Street, Kinnaird Street, Lincoln Street and Sparks Street, in said City of Cambridge, be specifically repaired, in accordance with future estimate and design to be prepared by the Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and a future Memorandum of Agreement to be made between the said City of Cambridge and the said Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth - copies of said Agreement and design and estimate to be filed in the office of said Commissioners; and the said Commissioners expressly reserving for future return description of the manner and limits of the said specific repairs of said way upon the execution of said future Memorandum of Agreement therefor.

AND, whereas it appears that the Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Mayor of the City of Cambridge have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding U-194 dated November 3, 1965, whereby the said Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth agrees to set aside the sum of \$74,000 for the purpose of such work - subject to monies being appropriated by the General Court for Chapter 90 projects; said Memorandum of Understanding being also subject to future contract for the proposed work; and whereas it appears that the estimated cost of said work is \$148,000 and the City has available \$37,000.

Now, therefore, said Commissioners do hereby direct that upon the completion of the work to be hereafter described by future return of said Commissioners to the acceptance and satisfaction of said Commissioners and said Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth, the County shall pay to the said City of Cambridge one-fourth (1/4) of the cost of the work done, but not exceeding the sum of Thirty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$37,000.).

In this matter, John E. Shaughnessy, of Stoneham, acted in place of John L. Danehy, County Commissioner, under the provisions of Section 12, Chapter 34, General Laws - said John L. Danehy, being disqualified to act in said matter due to residence in said City of Cambridge.

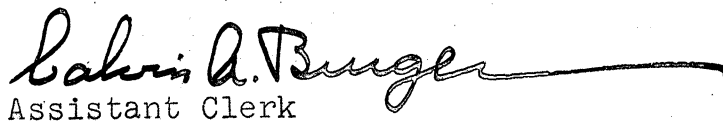

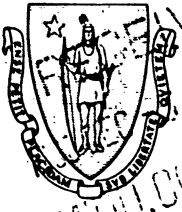

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Relative to the improvement of a section of road in said City/Town under the provisions of Section 34, Chapter 90 of the General Laws, Ter. Ed. and Acts in amendment thereof and in addition thereto.

The Massachusetts Department of Public Works, hereinafter referred to as the Department, agrees to set aside the sum of \$ 74000 for the City/Town upon commencement of the Chapter 90 project (s) on see reverse side St./Rd./Ave. in the said City/Town subject to monies being appropriated by the General Court for Chapter 90 projects.

The Department and the City/Town agrees that this Memorandum of Understanding is subject to a future contract for the proposed project(s) which will be drawn up by the Department and approved by both parties.
