IN CITY COUNCIL

April 22, 1974

ORDERED:

That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter 3, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to John Cowles, doing business as C. and S. Talking Machine Company, for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalk in front of premises numbered 864 Massachusetts Avenue, provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and providing further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner will file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.
