WHEREAS: Senior citizens live in fear of crime and its trauma on neighborhoods and individuals; and

WHEREAS: One problematic institution seems to be in large senior housing developments throughout the City of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: It is incumbent on City resources to be used to allay the fears and improve the quality of life for its citizenry; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Police commissioner with the view in mind of instructing area patrols to utilize the park and walk approach in those neighborhoods with senior housing with police personnel visiting seniors in lobbies and common rooms; and be it further

ORDERED: That particular attention be paid to Miller River Apartments, Kennedy Apartments and Manning Apartments.
