

City of Cambridge,

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-seven,

An ordinance in amendment of an ordinance in relation to the Office of Auditor of Accounts.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 1, of the Revised Ordinances is hereby amended by adding after the word "determine" in the fifth line thereof, the words: "no person shall be eligible as Auditor who has been appointed or elected to any other office by the City Council, or either branch thereof. And an election or appointment of any person holding the office of Auditor of Accounts to any such office shall be a vacation of the office of Auditor of Accounts. The Auditor shall be removable at the pleasure of the City Council."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect on the first Monday of January next.
