We understand that the Cooper Play Park, at the corner of Hancock and Centre Street, along with the Library totlot, have been recommended for renovation.

We should like to bring your attention the enclosed letter and petition expressing neighborhood concern over the status of the Cooper Play Park.

One of our special concerns is that a major piece of equipment, a metal slide, has had to be removed because it was unsafe. This leaves a gaping hole in the play facilities of this popular park.

We would appreciate your support in expediting the funding necessary for the overdue renovation to the Cooper Play Park. Our May 9th meeting will be devoted to this issue.
