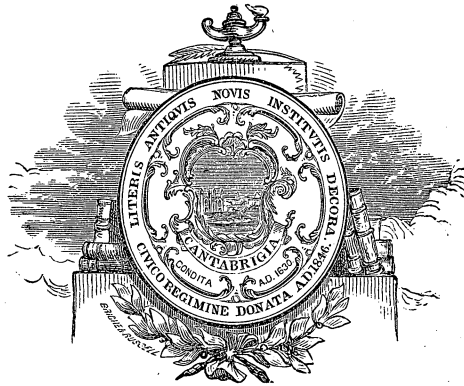


# CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Mayor and Aldermen, June 5, 1867.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that Main Street should be widened on its westerly side, from the junction of Main and Harvard Street ~~should be~~ to a point a little easterly of the junction of Main and Mount Auburn Street, it is therefore hereby Ordered, that due notice be given to the several persons whose land would be taken for said widening, and all other persons interested

that this Board intends to widen Main Street before mentioned, by taking a portion of Main land and laying out the same as a public street—and that Wednesday, the 19<sup>th</sup> day of June current at 9<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> o'clock, P. M., is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
