In Board of Aldermen, June 27th 1880

The Joint Standing Committee on Roads & Bridges, to which was referred the Petition of the Bay State Brick Company, praying that Spruce Street may be widened & properly graded would respectfully

Report that Spruce Street was accepted in 1724, that there are no plans or records showing the boundaries of the street, that they have examined the street as at present fenced, & find it very narrow & crooked, & very improperly graded, That it is the opinion of your Committee, that this street should be improved in all these particulars, & recommends that the City Engineer be directed to prepare plans & profile of this street, from North to its westerly terminus, & that further action on this petition be delayed until plans are prepared.
