Notice is hereby given that the Department of Public Works, acting under the provisions of Chapter 91 of the General Laws as amended by Chapters 516 and 524, Acts of 1950; Chapter 568; Acts of 1954 and Chapter 5 of the Acts of 1955, will give a public hearing on Monday, March 30, 1959, at 10:30 A.M. in the Hearing Room on the Fourth Floor of the Public Works Building, 100 Nashua Street, Boston, to all parties interested in petitions for the improvement, development, maintenance and protection of tidal and non-tidal rivers and streams, harbor, tidewaters, foreshores and shores along a public beach, including the Merrimack and Connecticut Rivers.

The Department requires the vote of the municipality to assume liability, under the provisions of section 29 of Chapter 91, for damages that may be incurred by the work. Petitions should be filed with the Department not later than March 26, 1959. It is requested that petitions for all desired projects be filed even though such projects have previously been presented.


