Edmund A. Whitman having resigned as a member of the Board of Public Welfare, on July 14, 1931, it is fitting and proper that the City Council manifest public appreciation of his long and faithful service to the public.

Mr. Whitman was an active member of the board for fifteen years and always showed a deep interest in the unfortunates who found it necessary to make application for relief.

He advocated and staunchly labored for the building of a new City Home, overlooking Fresh Pond, giving freely of his valuable time in the accomplishment of the same. To-day this beautiful building stands as a monument to his foresight and bespeaks the innermost feelings of his heart towards the indigent of our city. It is therefore

Whitman for the profound interest he has taken in the public affairs of the City of Cambridge, especially in that important branch of the service - the Board of Public Welfare - of which he was a member for fifteen years.
