The amendment will consist of a final submittal of the Massachusetts 1990 Base Year Emission Inventories for Volatile Organic Compounds, Nitrogen Oxides, and Carbon Monoxide, as required by the federal Clean Air Act Amendments (CAAA) of 1990, section 182(c).

This hearing is being held to gather public comments on the Massachusetts 1990 Base Year Emission Inventories for Volatile Organic Compounds, Nitrogen Oxides, and Carbon Monoxide before the document is submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
