WHEREAS: The National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) announced recently that Massachusetts Public Health Preparedness Region 4b, has been recognized as "Public Health Ready," a recognition that follows a lengthy application and review by public health officials from throughout the country. Cambridge is one of 27 communities in Region 4b; and
