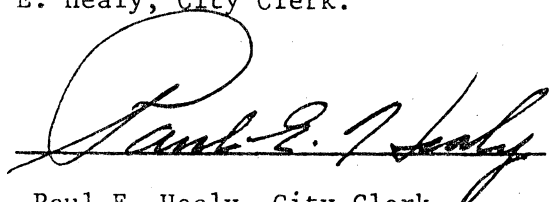

- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the tragic death of the Reverend Jerzy Popieluszko, a Polish Priest who was active in the Solidarity movement; and
- WHEREAS: It is alleged that Father Popieluszko was tortured prior to being thrown into a reservoir, where he was found four days after being kidnaped; and
- WHEREAS: This City Council has long been on record as being vehemently opposed to the imprisonment and/or inhumane treatment of political activists; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of the Reverend Jerzy Popieluszko and to the people of Poland to whom he served; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Popieluszko on behalf of the entire City Council.
