

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, May 17 1882

Ordered,

That the Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges be and hereby is instructed to cause brick sidewalks with suitable curb stone, to be laid on the following streets, to wit:

On Jay street, East side between River street and Western Avenue, about 400 ft.

On Jay street, West side, in front of estate of Joseph L. Drew, 100 feet.

On Mason street, both side in front of land of Shepard Congregational Church, about 200 feet.

On Garden street, West side, from Mason street northerly to Phillips place, about 425 feet.

The expense of such sidewalks to be assessed upon the abutters, in accordance with the provisions of the ~~statutes~~ statutes of the Commonwealth.
