WHEREAS:

At a recent meeting with the Deputy City Manager and others, residents of Bigelow Street made several suggestions for resolving present and future parking problems on their street; therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager, after consulting the Director of Traffic and Parking and other relevant officials, report in writing as soon as possible whether the following proposed solutions are feasible:

1. Removing the prohibition against all-night on street parking on Clinton Street.
2. Providing one or more additional on-street spaces between 35 Bigelow Street and the corner of Harvard Street, on the west side of Bigelow Street
3. Dedicating some parking for city employees in the present Green-Pleasant lot, or making arrangements for their use of the Y.M.C.A. lot.
4. Allowing residents to park overnight in the lot behind 5 Bigelow Street
5. Enforcing existing rules more strictly, especially against non-resident parking and in the Green Pleasant Lot.
