An Ordinance

Establishing the Office of Superintendent of
Garb Washington - and prescribing his duties.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Sec. 1. There shall be chosen annually, at the commencement of each municipal year, and whenever a vacancy exists, by concurrent vote of the City Council, to be first acted upon by the Mayor and Aldermen, one suitable person, to be styled the Superintendent of Garb Washington, who shall hold his office at the pleasure of the City Council, and shall perform the duties of ~~the~~ same without compensation.

Sec. 2. The Superintendent of Garb Washington shall have the general care and superintendence of the property

at the Fair, shall have the custody of the Flag or Ensign and shall ~~display~~ cause the same to be displayed on all public occasions, and shall cause said Flag to be kept in repair, ~~at the expense of the City~~ and the topmast to be hoisted, when necessary, and again hoisted, at the expense of the City.
