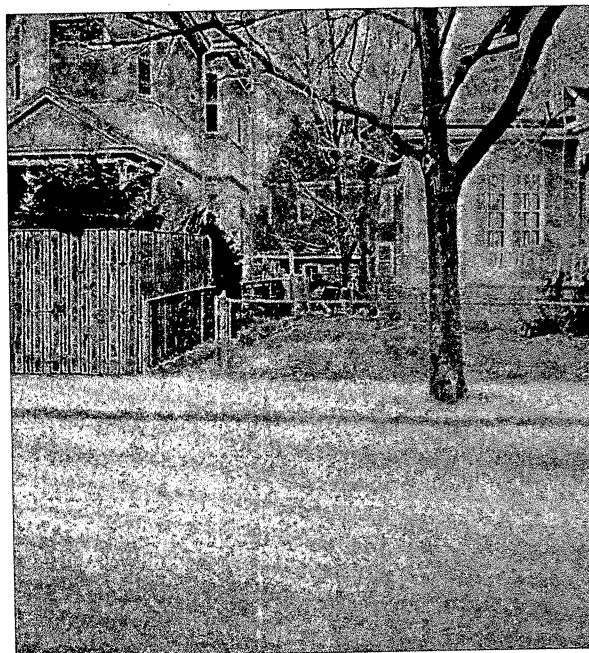
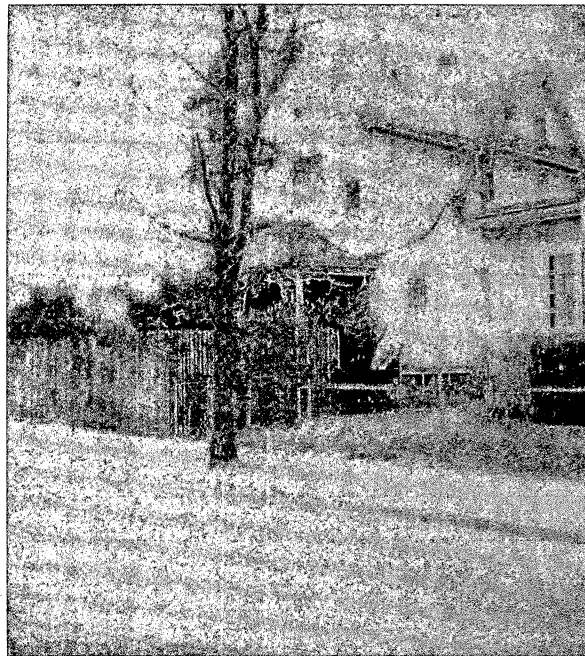

APPLICATION FOR DRIVEWAY CUTS AND OPENINGS

INSTRUCTIONS:

In order to obtain permission for a driveway cut or opening you must first get approval from the Department of Inspectional Services on the zoning requirements for off-street parking, including the cooperation of your immediate abuttors.

To receive a review from Inspectional Services you must fill out Part I of the application. Be sure to draw your plot plan on Drawing 1, choosing the lot that represents your lot's position, i.e. corner or interior. You must also include a sketch of the proposed driveway, including dimensions, on Drawing 2. You may then calculate the cost of the driveway by using the formula based on your choice of surfaces. You must also include a signed abuttor sheet for each of your abuttors: back yard, one on either side and the abuttor directly across the street.

Once you have gathered this information on the application, it should be submitted to:

If the application is approved by Inspectional Services, it will then be sent on to Traffic and Parking, the Historical Commission and the Department of Public Works. If approved by Public Works, the application and backup will be sent to the City Council for their approval. Once the City Council approves, the driveway curb cut can be installed. However, the full cost of the cut must be paid to Public Works before the work will start.

If, however, Inspectional Services denies your application you may then appeal to the Zoning Board of Appeals.

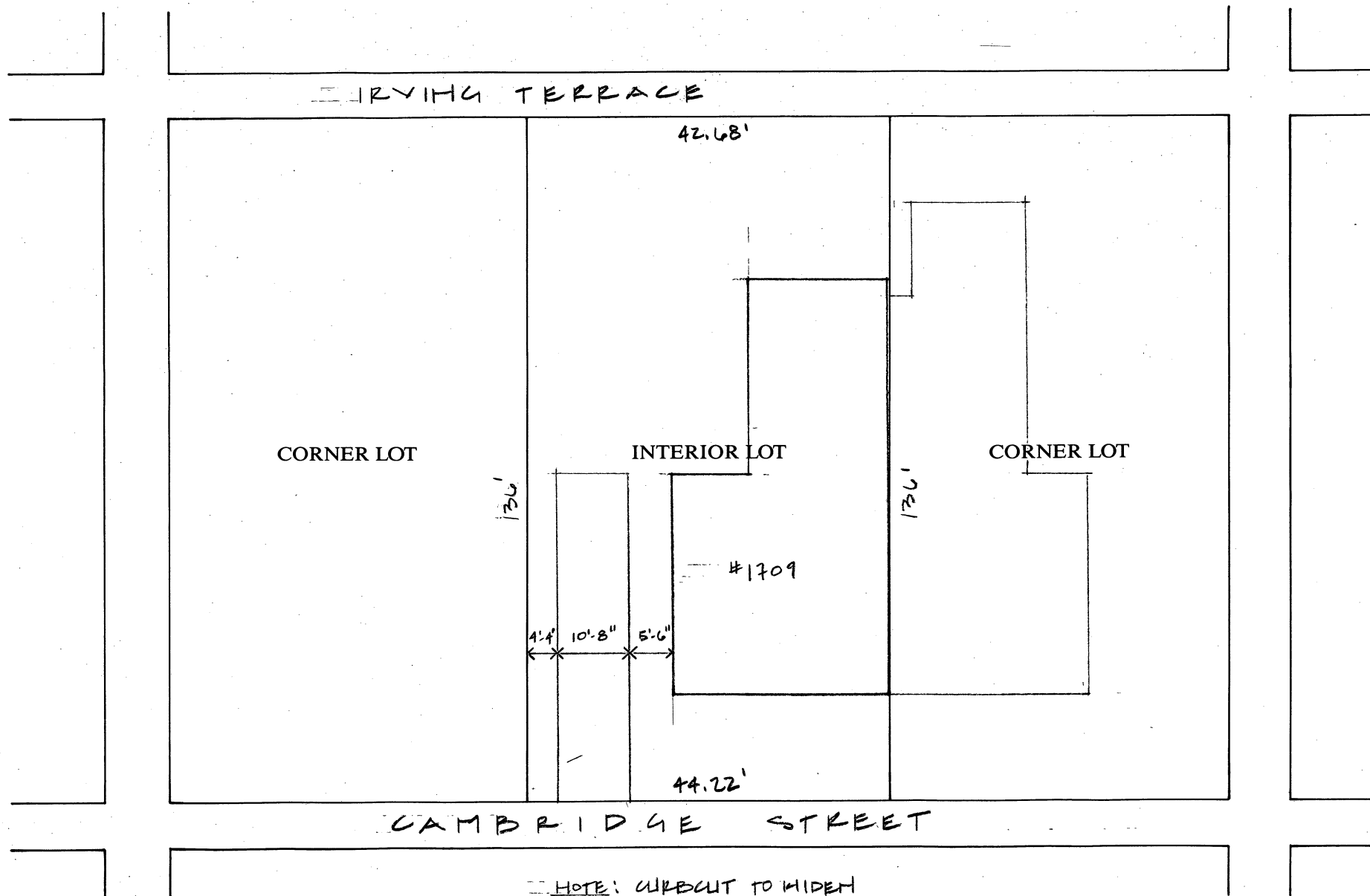

I have enclosed a copy of the completed application for extending the existing curbscut at 1709 Cambridge Street. As I mentioned to you, we would like to have the landscape contractor do the widening of the curbscut, provided that it is acceptable to the City.

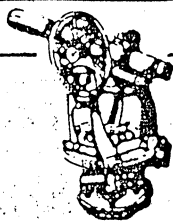
I will be in touch with you to be sure that you have all the information needed. Thank you for your help in this matter.

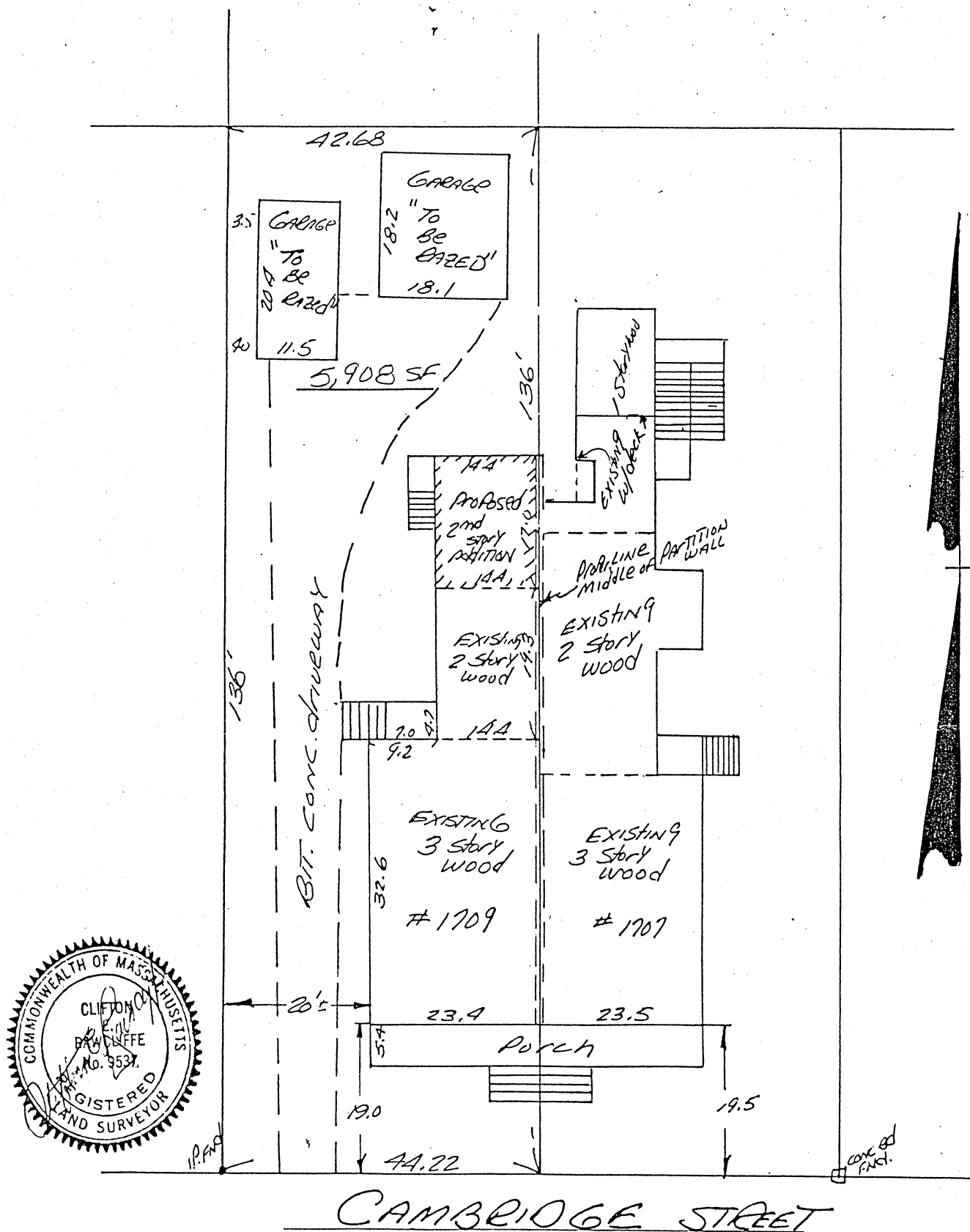

ST. CAMBRIDGE, MASS.

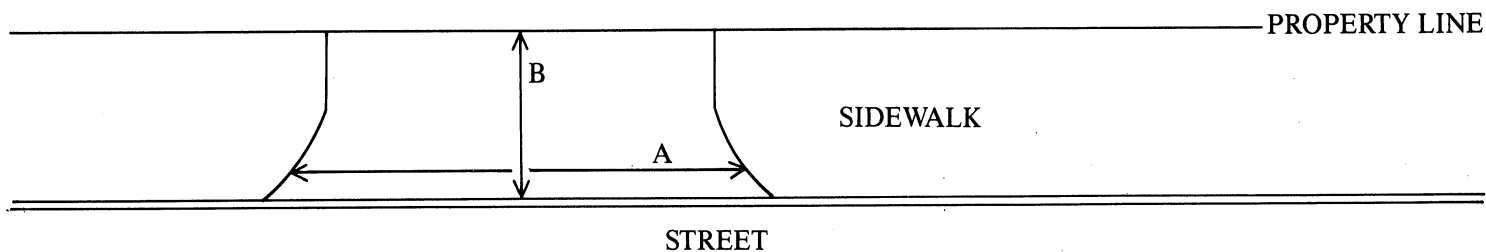

PROPOSED OUTLINE SCOPE OF WORK and GENERAL NOTES

Refer to Drawings X-1, SK-14, SK-15, SK-16 revised 03.16.92

DEMOLITION

General Notes:

- a. Disposal: Unless otherwise noted or directed, all removed materials to be legally disposed of off site.
- b. Protection: Provide protective measures as required to provide free and safe passage of Owner, Owner's personell and general public at all times.
- c. Traffic: Conduct selective demolition operations and debris removal to ensure minimum interference with streets and walks and other adjacent occupied facilities. Do not close, block or otherwise obstruct such passageways without written permission from authorities having jurisdiction. Provide alternate routes as required.
- d. Utility Service: Maintain existing utilities indicated to remain and protect them against damage during demolition. Interruption of utility service must be authorized by authorities having jurisdiction and the Owner in writing.
- e. Environmental Controls: Use water sprinkling, temporary enclosures, and other methods to limit dust and dirt migration; except no calcium chloride will be allowed for dust control. Comply with governing regulations pertaining to environmental protection.
- f. Hazardous Materials: All applicable regulations and standards must be adhered to in the removal and handling of any hazardous materials.

Work:

1. Remove exisitng asphalt paving and any underlieing materials complete to subgrade.
2. Remove (6) concrete footings from rear yard, 1'-0" dia., depth unknown.
3. Remove (4) trees and stumps complete, pull (2) stumps and cut (1) stump minimum 6" below grade. Refer to drawings for locations.
4. Remove wood curbing at planting bed along driveway, approximately 40 LF.

NEW CONSTRUCTION

General Notes:

- a. Contractor to verify all dimensions, grades, levels and quantities in the field.
- b. Warranty: Work of this contract to be fully warranted by the Contractor for a minimum of one year from date of substantial completion of the work.
- c. Protection of Work: Protect new work and existing work from traffic and erosion. Keep areas free of trash and debris.
- d. Settling: Where settling is measurable or observable at excavated areas during general project warranty period, remove surface (pavement, lawn, or other finish), add backfill material, compact, and replace surface treatment. Restore appearance, quality and surface of finish to match adjacent work and eliminate evidence of restoration to greatest extent possible.
- e. Certifications: Provide vendor's certified statements for grass seed mixture and plant materials installed, stating common and botanical names. For grass seed provide percentages by weight, percentages of purity, germination, and weed seed for each grass seed species.
- f. Instructions: Provide written instructions recommending procedures to be established by Owner for maintenance of landscape work throughout full year. Submit prior to expiration of required warranty period.

Work:

1. Prepare ground surface as required: Remove vegetation, debris, unsatisfactory soil materials, obstructions and deleterious materials from ground surface prior to placement of fills.
Prepare subgrades as necessary for specified work.
 - 1.1 Under seeded and unpaved areas: Compact top 6" of subgrade and each layer of backfill or fill material at 90% maximum density.
 - 1.2 Under paved areas: Compact top 6" of subgrade and each layer of backfill or fill material at 95% maximum density.
2. Backfill and Fill: Use satisfactory excavated or borrow material.
 - 2.1 Place backfill and fill materials in layers not more than 8" in loose depth for material compacted by heavy compaction equipment, and not more than 4" in loose depth for material compacted by hand operated tampers.
 - 2.2 Where subgrade or layer of soil material must be moisture conditioned before compaction, uniformly apply water to surface of subgrade or layer of soil material. Apply water in minimum quantity as necessary to prevent free water from appearing on surface during or subsequent to compaction operations.

3. Topsoil: Topsoil may have been stockpiled from work in other sections for re-use in landscape work. If quantity of stockpiled topsoil is insufficient, provide additional topsoil as required to complete landscape work.

3.1 Topsoil to be fertile, friable natural loam, surface soil, free of subsoil, clay, brush, weeds, roots, stumps, stones larger than 2" in any dimension and other extraneous or deleterious material.

4. Grading: Uniformly grade areas of new work and adjacent transition areas as necessary. Smooth finish surface and compact with uniform levels or slopes between points where elevations are indicated or between such points and existing grades.

3.1 Grade areas adjacent to building or other structures to drain away from structures and to prevent ponding.

3.2 Finish and sub grades to pitch to drain as shown: High point to be established at threshold of gate in new fence.

5. Paving: New Driveway, Courtyard area and Rear Yard to be paved as shown on drawings and as specified. Materials to be installed on fully prepared subbase.

5.1 Base layer: 6" crushed stone (1/2")

5.2 Setting layer: 2" stone dust

5.3 Driveway: Red Brick Paver "LeChance" to match existing front walkway. Laid in running bond parallel to Cambridge Street. Joints to be centered, even and aligned. Existing front walkway to be extended as required by relocation of driveway. Approx. Area: 510 SF.

5.4 Courtyard: 1" Bluestone random rectangular pavers. Colors to be selected: no violet, no brown. Tight joints. Area as designated on the drawings, approx. 700 SF

5.5 Rear Yard: 1" Bluestone random rectangular pavers. Colors to be selected: no violet, no brown. Tight joints continuous with Courtyard paving. Area at base of deck steps as designated on the drawings, approx. 125 SF

6. Curbs and Edging: Refer to drawings for locations and elevations.

6.1 Granite Curbing: 4" x 18" by specified lengths, installed with reveals as noted and specified. Split face sides, polished top face. Approx. 91 LF at planting beds and walkway.

6.2 Brick Edging: Install red brick soldier course edging at West edge of driveway and East edge of neighbors driveway. Brick to be "LeChance" as driveway above. Brick edging to be installed flush with surface of driveways. Approx. 102 LF

Alternate: Substitute Reyerson steel edging for brick edging at driveway above. Install top edge flush to 1/2" below surface of paving material. Approx. 102 LF

Alternate: Substitute 4" granite curbs for brick edging above. Install top edge flush with paving material. Approx. 102 LF

6.3 Steel Edging: Install Reyerson steel edging between Courtyard paving and other finish at East edge of Courtyard. Install top edge flush to 1/2" below surface of paving material. Approx. 28 LF

Alternate: Substitute 4" granite curbs for steel edging above. Approx. 28 LF

6.4 Granite Curb "Threshold" at new fence gate: 8" x 18" x 10' long, installed flush with paving materials. Split face sides and polished top face.

7. Grass Seed and Plant Materials:

7.1 Provide soil amendents as required.

7.2 Lawn: Fine grade lawn areas to smooth, even surface with loose, uniformly fine texture. Moisten soil if necessary. Distribute seed evenly over entire area. Rake seeded areas lightly into top 1/8" of soil and water lightly with fine spray. Grass seed to be fresh, clean new-crop seed compatible with existing soil and exposure requirements.

7.3 Plant materials: Provide and install materials according to the drawings and schedule below. Note: additional planting may be contracted separately.

8. Other Finish Materials:

8.1 Install 1/2" crushed stone, compacted to 6" at Courtyard bed as shown. Stone material to be of uniform color (gray), clean and free from extraneous materials and litter.

8.2 Areas not seeded, paved or otherwise finished to have minimum 6" topsoil, fine graded for future planting. Includes, planting beds along east side of driveway and full area between driveways.

9. Drainage:

9.1 House roof drainage: Splash blocks, drains, leaders, etc. to be retained in place or reinstalled at new levels. Adjust, shorten or lengthen leaders as required; new work to match existing materials, dimensions and finish.

9.2 Graded and paved areas to drain away from house foundation and in such a way as to prevent flooding of neighboring properties.

9.3 Upper and lower planting beds to have 6"w. x 12"d. exposed gravel drip edge along foundation wall, no edge to loam.
