To the Honorable the Mayor and Aldermen
Gentlemen.

The City Engineer,
to whom was referred the petition of Chas. Vaughan
for the "line of Concord Avenue near its junction
with Garden St.", reports as follows.

This street was originally laid out
as a turnpike road, under an act of incorpora-
tion, in 1804. In 1828, the franchise in
the same was relinquished and abandoned and
in 1829, it was laid out as a highway by
the County Commissioners.

From encroachments which
were understood to exist upon certain sections
of the street, a survey was made of that
portion which lies between Garden St. and Vas-
sal Lane in August 1857, and the line adopt-
ed and established by the Board of Mayor and
Aldermen Sept. 23^d 1857.

I have given to the petition-
er the line of said street as definitely fixed

by this last action; but, since the abutments on this part of the street have never conformed their fences to these lines, it seems necessary that the City Government should take some further action to secure the full width of the street, as well as fix more permanently the boundaries of the remaining portion of the street within the limits of the City.
