- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Doris Murphy has retired from the City Clerk's Office effective November 30, 2007; and
- WHEREAS: Doris began her employment with the City of Cambridge in August, 1982 as a Temporary Clerk Typist for the Cambridge Rent Control Board, which was then located upstairs from Woolworth's in the middle of Central Square; and
- WHEREAS: With the exception of a two-year hiatus from April 1988 until August 1990, and a six-month stint as an Administrative Assistant to the Law Department to cover another employee's leave of absence, Doris worked for the Cambridge Rent Control Board from August 1982 until January 1996 when rent control in Cambridge ended. During that time Doris held the positions of Clerk Typist, Executive Secretary, Senior Legal Stenographer and Administrative Assistant; and
- WHEREAS: In November 1988 Doris resumed her work for the City of Cambridge as a Senior Stenographer for the City of Cambridge as a Senior Stenographer for the Cambridge City Clerk's Office, the position from which she retired; and
- WHEREAS: During her tenure as an employee for the City of Cambridge, Doris was noted for her careful and conscientious attention to details and her exemplary customer service ethic; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record expressing its appreciation to Doris Murphy for her nineteen years of dedicated service to the citizens and to the City of Cambridge and wish her much happiness in her retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Doris Murphy on behalf of the entire City Council.
