WHEREAS: Cambridge citizens played a significant role in both the Revolutionary War and the War of 1812 and are duly honored by the site known as the Memorial Flagstaff; and

WHEREAS: The Memorial Flagstaff is so sited as to provide an attractive and prominent vista to travelers approaching from Massachusetts Avenue, both north and south, Garden Street, and Cambridge Street; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge should enable visitors to our historic area to be able to view at all times the American flag and this beautiful and historic tribute to our brave defenders of American freedom; and

WHEREAS: A source of electric current is readily and conveniently available for minimal trenching and wiring from a Peabody Street outlet; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be instructed to illuminate the Memorial Flagstaff and flag during night-time hours and make arrangements to initiate the lighting with an appropriate dedication ceremony.
