- WHEREAS: At best, there is a great deal of inconvenience caused to neighbors through noise, traffic and parking congestion, dust and so forth; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to ensure that at all construction sites;
- City Ordinances with regard to allowable hours for construction, noise, parking and traffic, and construction practices are rigidly enforced and that police details are carefully instructed to manage properly any safety issues that arise; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to designate a particular City employee who is responsible for seeing that this enforcement is carried out.
