Subject City Council Order #21, 10/22/90 Re: Enforcement of Resident Parking on Everett St.

The Traffic Department has been tagging the illegally parked vehicles on Everett Street and special attention was given between the hours of 12:00 noon and 2:00 PM and 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM.

The records indicated that from 10-23-90 to 11-1-90 our officers issued 64 parking tickets, 41 (64%) of these were for resident parking violations. The other 23 (36%) were for parking in restricted areas.

We will continue this effort and monitor our results to insure that we get rid of these illegal parkers.
