To the Hon Mayor & Aldermen
City of Cambridge
Gentlemen,

The County Commissioners have viewed Arlington Avenue at its junction with North Avenue, and propose to widen the same to 98 feet to the centre of Arlington; providing you will widen North Avenue to that width from Cedar St to our line. We therefore petition your Hon Board to make such changes as will render North Avenue & Arlington Avenue not less than 98 feet in width between Cedar St and our line. Allow us to hope that early action may be taken in this matter, that we may present the same to the County Commissioners during this month if possible, and your petitioners will ever pray.
