**ORDERED:**

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to establish an immediate procedure whereby it will be mandatory for any contractor working in any public way in the City of Cambridge, to notify any and all households and businesses that may be effected by utility cut-offs in the course of construction, and be it further

**ORDERED:**

That the above request should be accomplished by contractors and their agents ringing door bells or notifying by mail therresidents to be effected, and be it further

**ORDERED:**

That a procedure also be established that prior to any traffic detour's being implemented that all approaches to said detour be clearly posted 500 feet in advance, and be it further

**ORDERED:**

That failure to comply with this procedure shall result in penalties to the offender.
