WHEREAS: A major story in today's TAB points out that a huge increase in trolley tours is planned for this summer in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Minuteman Trolley in a hearing before the Cambridge License Commission tomorrow night, May 12th, proposes to increase from two to three trolleys serving 10,000 tourists annually in Cambridge, to twelve trolleys, serving 60,000 visitors, leaving in front of Cardullo's every ten minutes this summer; and

WHEREAS: This City Council is in receipt of numerous complaints with regard to the intensity of traffic problems throughout the City; and

WHEREAS: This City Council has not yet had an opportunity to consider the proposal which will surely add to the congestion now experienced by most residents; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the License Commission be requested to postpone its hearing and decision until the City Council has had an opportunity to fully review the proposal.
