I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$21,994.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$20,744.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$1,250.00). The Massachusetts Department of Education has awarded funds to the Community Learning Center as an implementation grant that follows the planning grant received by the Office of Workforce Development.
