WHEREAS: On December 11, 1984, friends and colleagues of Heather Ratcliffe will be gathering to commemorate her retirement from the Cambridge Chapter of the American Red Cross of Massachusetts Bay after 18 years of dedicated service; and

WHEREAS: Heather, who currently works as the Safety Services Director, has in the past worked with the Cambridge School Department, the Cambridge Police and Fire Departments and other organizations in the instruction of first aid, Cardiac-Pulmonary Resuscitation and other life-saving techniques; and

WHEREAS: Heather, who has worked as a Disaster Case Worker on both a local and national level, has also developed programs for the Red Cross Youth to assist the mentally handicapped, and organized "Voices From Home"- a program of recorded messages sent to servicemen overseas from their families at Christmas; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating and commending Heather Ratcliffe on 18 years of commitment to the citizens of Cambridge through her work with the Cambridge Red Cross that has touched many lives in a positive and helpful way during that time; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and is hereby requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Heather Ratcliffe on behalf of the entire City Council.
