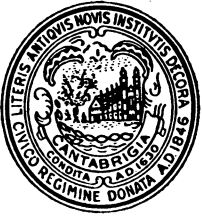

In accordance with Chapter 44, section 53 of the City Ordinance, the Cambridge Community Schools Program requests an appropriation in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) for the production of an opera workshop for City of Cambridge children. This workshop is to be conducted by the Cambridge Opera Workshop Company.

In August, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Council on Arts and Humanities awarded Cambridge Community Schools, City of Cambridge the sum of one thousand dollars to conduct the above program. The Cambridge City Council gave its approval to this contract in September. This amount will be forwarded to the City of Cambridge Executive account via voucher system of receipts to Mass. 
To the Honorable, the City Council:

I have been advised by Dr. Nancy C. Curtis, the Director of our Community Schools program, that the Massachusetts Council on Arts and Humanities has awarded the Cambridge Community Schools the sum of \$1,000.00 to conduct an Opera Work Shop for children in the City of Cambridge.

Dr. Curtis advises me that the Commonwealth grant to the City of Cambridge will be forwarded to us prior to June 30, 1972. Inasmuch as our City Auditor has recently determined that such grants should be deposited in the City's estimated receipts account, it will, therefore, not be available without the benefit of such an appropriation request is authorized by your Honorable Body.

I have prepared the enclosed appropriation order in the sum of \$1,000.00 the same to be included in and made part of the 1972 Tax Levy, but I remind your Honorable Body that an identical reimbursement is to be forwarded to the City by the Council on Arts and Humanities. The appropriation is to be made to the Miscellaneous Schedule - Community Schools, for use of the Opera Work Shop. I take the liberty of enclosing at this time a communication from Dr. Curtis advising us of this grant.
