The Committee on Roads and Bridges,

to which was ~~referred the petition~~ recommended the petition
of E. D. Brooks, praying for leave to lay a pipe
across Mound and Schol sheets.

Reports,

Recommending that
the permission asked for be granted as follows:-
The pipe to be laid across Mound sheet, at a
distance of about 100 feet from Schol sheet; also
across Schol sheet at a distance not exceeding
50 feet from Mound sheet, said pipe being for the
purpose of conveying water from a well. The
same to be laid under the direction and to the
satisfaction of the City Engineer, and said pipe to be
removed whenever the Board of Aldermen shall so
order.
