- WHEREAS: Family and friends of Gladys Hicks Hill will be gathering on October 25, 1985 at the Lenox Hotel in Boston to honor her with an Appreciation Dinner sponsored by the Lay Organization of St. Paul A.M.E. Church in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Gladys, originally from the Long Island area of New York, moved to Cambridge in 1943 with her husband Benjamin F. Hill and their four children; and
- WHEREAS: While in New York Gladys spent 27 years as an active member of the Calvary A.M.E. Church, serving in such capacities as Church Organist, Teacher of the Church School, Supervisor of the Allen Christian Endeavor League, Children's Choir Director and Missionary Society member; and
- WHEREAS: Upon their arrival in Cambridge the family's church membership was transferred to St. Paul A.M.E. Church and Gladys continued her church affiliations, serving as a member of the Philanthea Class where she held the office of Secretary for several years, Sunday School Superintendent for seven years, member of the Lay Organization including Secretary, Treasurer and, from 1966 to 1983, Laymen President; and
- WHEREAS: Gladys has also been First Vice President of the New England Conference Lay Organization, was Historiographer of the First District Lay Organization from 1966 to 1972, and has been a member of the St. Paul A.M.E. Church Stewardess Board #2 since 1964; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby express its official congratulations to Gladys Hicks Hill on the occasion of her Appreciation Dinner which honors a lifetime of serving and giving to others as "one of God's loyal and faithful soldiers," and extend to her and her entire family our heartfelt best wishes for continued success and happiness in the future.
