Provided:-

That the said Cambridge Loyal Order of Moose pay into the City Treasury the sum of fifty dollars (\$50) and
Provided further that the said Cambridge Loyal Order of Moose file with the City ~~of~~ of Cambridge a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages that may arise from the occupation and use of said land.
