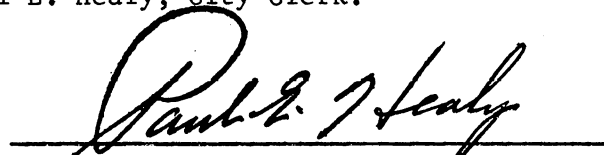

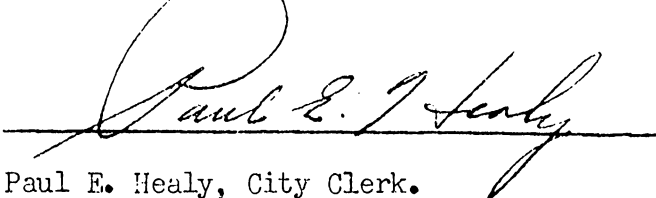
Enclosed herewith you will find the petition of Fresh Pond Sq. Assoc.
