WHEREAS: Thereafter, Mr. Savenor called this City Councillor and requested that I ask the Managing Director of the Inspectional Services who the City Councillor in Question was; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Pisani informed this City Councillor that the call was anonymous and volunteered to send a copy of the complaint to me; and

WHEREAS: Upon receipt of a copy of the complaint, I faxed a copy of same to Mr. Savenor who then responded by calling and questioning the written contents of the complaint; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to meet with the Managing Director of Inspectional Services and any other employee who was involved in this matter and with Mr. Barry Savenor so that the matter can be discussed in full and all questions can be answered and the matter resolved. It is further requested that this meeting be held as soon as possible by the manager, but in any event no later than October 31, 1994 and that a subsequent report be submitted to the City Council.
