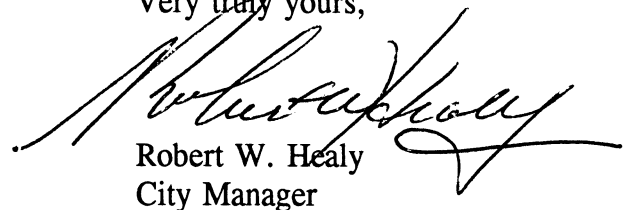

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$1,000.00 in the General Fund from Reserve to Commission on the Status of Women Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. These funds will be used to purchase the first 100,000 beverage napkins bearing the Cambridge After Hours Program logo. Clubs will seek a corporate sponsor for future purchases. The Cambridge After Hours Program is geared to create a late night safety zone in all of the areas in the City in which there is a concentration of entertainment establishments. The pilot program will be conducted in Central Square because of the high level of collaboration already among establishments, city agencies and community groups. Participating establishments will feature a colorful set of posters, beverage napkins and buttons worn by wait staff to signal that customers should make plans with friends for a safe way home and ask management for assistance if needed. Some other aspects of the program included owners and managers standing on the street after hours greeting and encouraging patrons to take care of each other and the neighborhood; taxi industry representatives will ensure extra cabs during closing hours; police will enhance walking and car patrols on the routes most patrons take to public transportation and parking areas.
