To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$10,247.29 in the Grant Fund from the Human Services Department Salary & Wages Account and Travel & Training Account to Human Services Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The Council on Aging has received funding for the Geriatric Outreach Substance Abuse Program (GOSAP) from Somerville-Cambridge Elder Services and from Title IIIB of the Elder Americans Act. These funds have been used to administer GOSAP for both Cambridge and Somerville. Beginning July 1, the program will be administered directly by the City of Somerville although services will continue in Cambridge. The funds that have already been received and appropriated by Cambridge will be paid to Somerville through a contract. This transfer moves all funds that have been appropriated into Salaries & Wages or Travel and Training into OOM so that a contract can be executed and encumbered and payments made.
