IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Oct. 20. 1886

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience
require that *Cleveland Street, so-called, extending*
from Dana Street to Ellery Street,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *thirty feet*
in width between *Dana and Ellery Streets*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W.A. Mason*
and *San. Surveyor*, and dated *August 24. 1885,*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the*
several owners and abutters, having waived the usual
notice and agreed to claim no damages on account of
such taking.

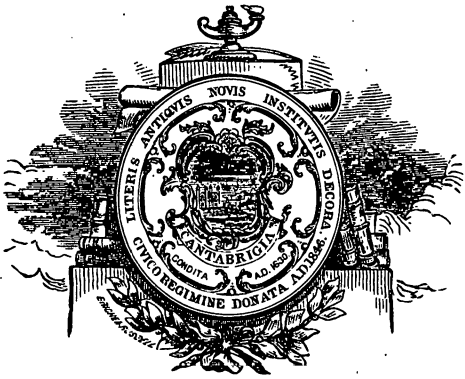
