- WHEREAS: The City Council wishes to recognize the contribution of officer Morris and of all the City's public safety employees who put themselves on the line for Cambridge citizens every day; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating Cambridge Police Officer Charlotte Morris for her role in saving a human life; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to Patrol Officer Morris.
