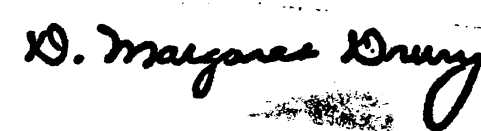

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$1,000 in the Grant Fund of the License Commission (Consumer Council) Other Ordinary Maintenance Account from the Executive Office of Elder Affairs. Somerville/Cambridge Elder Services has decided to award the City an extra \$1,000, making the grant total \$5,000. The remaining \$4,000 was appropriated in the FY 97 budget.

The funds will support work study payments for college interns utilizing the office. This money will result in nearly 400 hours of work because the City's portion of student salary is only 1/3 of their wages.
