That the south side of Main Street
from John Cuttings Store to Cherry St. be
brought up to its proper grade, and that a
curb stone be set in front of building numb-
ered 438 and 440. At this place the street,
has been dangerous ever winter; both to pedestrians
and vehicles. It being difficult to drive a horse
and sleigh to and from the door without upsetting.
Frequently water remains here,
and filters into the cellar. It being impossible for
it "to run up hill" into the cesspool.

Therefore we pray that this may
be attended to without delay.
