In City Council,
February 12, 1973

ORDERED:

That the sum of Two Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,800,000) be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of remodeling, reconstructing or making extraordinary repairs to the Cambridge Home for the Aged and Infirm and to meet said appropriation the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) shall be raised in the 1973 Tax Levy, and the City Treasurer with the approval of the City Manager and the Emergency Finance Board is hereby authorized to borrow the sum of Two Million Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,650,000) at one time or from time to time under the pursuant to Chapter 44, Section 7, Clause (3A) of the General Laws as amended and supplemented and to issue bonds or notes of the City thereof, each issue of such bonds or notes to be payable in not more than ten (10) years from its date, provided that the amount hereinbefore authorized to be borrowed shall be reduced by the amount of any grant or grants of State or Federal funds received for the aforesaid project prior to the sale of such bonds or notes.

ORDERED:

That the sum of Two Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,800,000) be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of remodeling, reconstructing or making extraordinary repairs to the Cambridge Home for the Aged and Infirm and to meet said appropriation the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) shall be raised in the 1973 Tax Levy, and the City Treasurer with the approval of the City Manager and the Emergency Finance Board is hereby authorized to borrow the sum of Two Million Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars \$2,650,000 at one time or from time to time under the pursuant to Chapter 44, Section 7, Clause (3A), of the General Laws as amended and supplemented and to issue bonds or notes of the City therefor, each issue of such bonds or notes to be payable in not more than ten (10) years from its date, provided that the amount hereinbefore authorized to be borrowed shall be reduced by the amount of any grant or grants of State or Federal funds received for the aforesaid project prior to the sale of such bonds or notes.

Passed to a second reading at meeting of the City Council held on February 12, 1973 and after February 26, 1973 the question may be on adoption.
