and urge all the citizens of Cambridge to support this event and participate fully in its observance.

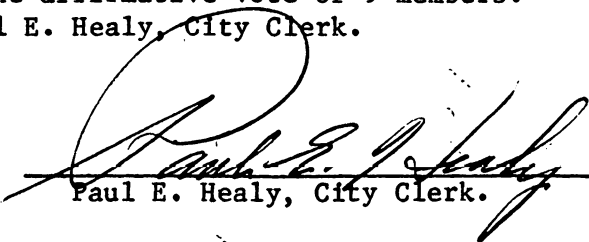
