In Board of Aldermen, May 4. 1887

Ordered,

That the usual order of notice be issued of the intention of this board to extend Winsor Street, from its present southerly terminus across Main Street to State Street, a private way so-called, by taking for such purpose certain parcels of land as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, to wit, a strip of land forty feet in width between said Main Street and said State Street, the western boundary thereof to begin at the north-easterly corner of the brick block, standing on the southerly side of said Main Street, and thence to extend along the easterly line of said block and in a straight line beyond said block to said State Street.

Such extension to be made under the provisions of the Statute in relation to betterments.
