

To the Honorable the Mayor and Aldermen
of the City of Cambridge;

Respectfully represent the undersigned that the
time allowed to them by your Honorable Board for removing the
buildings owned and occupied by them on Brattle Street, preparatory
to the widening of said Street, may be extended to October 1st, 1871,
as the said removal cannot conveniently be made by them by the ~~fifteenth~~
day of May, previous, as ordered by your Honorable Board, ~~since~~ their
respective houses will be, in the interval between the present time and
said ~~fifteenth~~ day of May in constant use and occupation by boarders
and roomers. But that they will have opportunity to effect
said changes in whole, or chiefly, during the College vacation, if per-
mitted to defer said removal as above.
